# Private House, North London



BWA's work at this North London house involved substantial structural alterations and general internal refurbishment to turn the house from a tired, badly planned residence into a new, stylish family home.

The design included the demolition of a large two storey 1960's rear conservatory, in order to allow the construction of a much smaller contemporary glazed addition. This accommodates a new stair and provides direct access to the rear garden from the upper ground floor.

The extension is extensively glazed on the upper level, with steel doors and windows to both the upper and lower ground floors.





On the second floor, the children's rooms and their bathroom have been totally re-designed, as has a third floor, where BWA created a generous Master Bedroom suite with spectacular views.
