



Private House, Holland Park



The owners of this elegant West London house initially approached BWA in order to re-organise their dilapidated lower ground floor and master bedroom area.



In the end the entire three lower floors were refurbished and the connection reinforced between the house and beautifully landscaped garden, the latter achieved by creating a glass deck and lightweight staircase leading from the upper enclosed living areas to the terrace and lawn below.

The lower ground floor was opened up into a series of interlocking spaces, all strongly unified by the use of a warm limestone floor.



The upper ground floor consists of a more formal sitting and study area, on the garden side, and another impressive garden room with great views and lots of natural light coming from a skylight.

The grand rooms on the first floor have been altered to provide a luxurious master bathroom, a generous dressing room with cherry veneered doors, and a reconfigured, yet beautifully proportioned bedroom, with the bed positioned so as to enjoy the exceptional views of the Square and church opposite.

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
